# **Product Description, Intended use, Application**

The protection sheet, **size 100 x 210 cm**, is provided with a transparent plastic coating which is impermeable to liquids. The absorbent protection sheet rapidly absorbs liquids, while the foil coating on its underside prevents that the sheet is soaked. The product is reinforced with **48 blue threads** to increase its tensile strength and stability. The protection sheet is used in medical sectors and in nursing to protect stretchers, couches, beds, or tables from soiling, thus reducing the risk of contamination and counteracting the spread of germs. The protection sheet is for single use.

#### Composition

Cellulose, polyethylene, polyester

### **Contra-Indications**

No contra-indications known.

The product should not be used in the case of a known allergy against the material.
